

John Edwin Colton R.D.Y.P., an Appreciation.



I'm not sure when I first met John, I think it was when I was Treasurer of the Yorkshire Philatelic Association in the late 1980s and he was the Rotherham P.S. delegate. He worked for the National Provincial Bank and knew my uncle, Herbert Hindle, who was the manger of the Broomhill branch in Sheffield, which helped develop our friendship.

John joined Sheffield P.S. in 1997, although, as a member of Rotherham P.S. and the Yorkshire Postal History Society, he was well known to us as he was a regular visitor to Sheffield with inter-society visits.

He then acted as delegate for both Sheffield and Rotherham P.S. to the Yorkshire Philatelic Association, becoming their President for the 2001-02 season. He gave many displays around the county. He won many Sheffield and Y.P.A. competitions, eventually graduating to national and international level. He signed the Roll of Distinguished Yorkshire Philatelists in 2005. His only term as President of Sheffield was in the 2004-05 season.

His knowledge of philately was quite extensive. John was always very generous with his time and always willing to help. He was an eloquent speaker when giving his displays, which made them even more interesting.

He was an avid collector including displays of Rotherham Postal History, Bavaria along with several "offshoot" collections. He gave many displays to us, either as President of Sheffield, President of the Yorkshire Philatelic Association or as an invited speaker.

In the latter years of his life, his attention was drawn to Free Fronts, especially those signed by Yorkshire M.Ps. and clergy. He wrote a book on the GB Failed Free Hand Stamps of the Franking System with R. B. Galland as well as writing articles about special cancellations used by the Royal Mail to validate the use of the free post system.

Although he was unable to attend meetings over the last few years, several of our members kept in touch either on the phone or visits to his home.

His knowledge and friendship will be missed by all who knew him.

Chat with Greg Spring of Cavendish Philatelic Auctions

Greg Spring spoke about differences in 'buying at auction' and 'selling at auction'. Cavendish doesn't buy anything to sell, but takes everything on consignment. Buying at an auction is a contract. The bid made is binding.

As Cavendish only deals with consignments, they 'live' off the commissions. Cavendish sells stamps but their speciality is postal history. Dr. Spring's general advice was 'don't collect to invest' because the value of items could be volatile. He showed a display hand cancelled envelopes prior to postage stamps which were used on the railways of Tuscany. Use of the railways incurred an additional charge to postage. These cancellations were supposed to be on the back of the envelope but his examples were all cancelled on the front!
