'What I am Doing Now'.

Members shared some of their recent activities giving us a chance to talk about a range of subjects which we would not normally have a chance to discuss in Richard Hindle spoke about meetings. covers, Andrew Fullen about the Empire Jubilee Stamps of George V, Ken Rutter spoke about 'Collecting: How I do it', Neil Ritchie about editing philatelic journals, John Hunter spoke about post cards showing coaling of ships as a source of social history, Robert Millard talked about aerogrammes and James H. and the Galapagos post, Grayson spoke about research he is doing for an academic article looking at the use of religious symbolism on the stamps of North and South Korea. In addition, there was a lot of wide ranging discussion on a number of other topics, and the meeting concluded with a presentation by Richard Hindle on his competition display and how he did it.

Display: Frank Walton Memorial Display

Mike Roberts FRPSL, President of The Royal Philatelic Society of London. 'Pacific Steam Navigation Company'. Mr. Roberts spoke about the origins of the company in 1840 and how by 1873 it had developed into the largest shipping company by tonnage. It expanded from its original routes along the west coast of South America to a line linking both coasts of the continent with Europe. From the early twentieth century it added cruising. The line continued until 1965 when it was absorbed by Furness Witthy and latterly sold to a Korean shipping company. Mr. Roberts used a powerpoint display to provide an overview of the talk. The display in two sessions had a wide variety of materials including tickets, proposed postage stamps, photographs, posters, telegrams, maps, postcards and other items..
